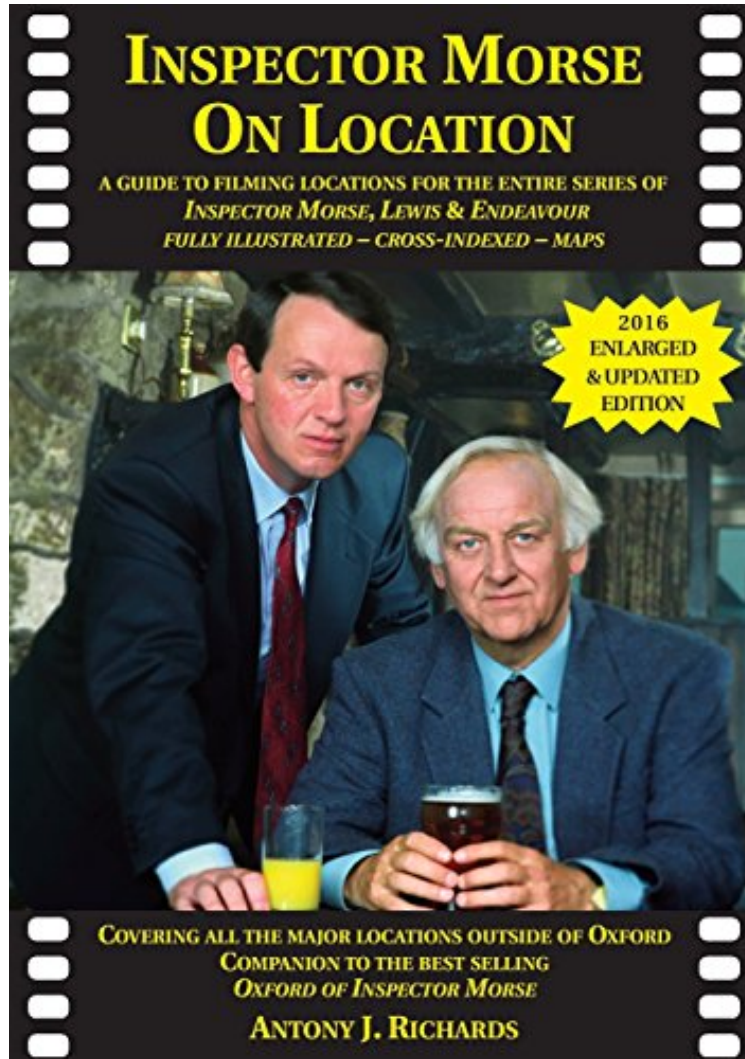

Covering 11 counties from Aldbury in Hertfordshire in Herefordshire to Woodstock in Oxfordshire, Inspector Morse on Location, published in conjunction with the Inspector Morse Society, surveys over 75 locations that are most

associated with the television productions of Inspector Morse (and all 5 series of Lewis). It not only gives the Morse and Lewis connections, along with filming anecdotes, but concentrates on the historical aspects of each site, most of which are open to the public and are of interest in their own right. The guide is fully indexed by county, episode and location type and covers everything from public houses and breweries to churches and stately homes. Inspector Morse on Location is fully illustrated and even contains location maps to assist the reader in planning visits. This publication is a companion to The Oxford of Inspector Morse, by Antony J.
