High school/college kids visit the sites of holocaust history...By CustomerJOURNEY OF CONSCIENCE started as a high school English class called "Literature of the Holocaust" at Cleveland Heights High school in Ohio. In this class students read holocaust related books as well as heard from actual holocaust survivors about their experiences. The "Journey" itself took members of this class to Europe and Israel to discover the places they'd studied for themselves.Guided by the class instructor, a chaperone, and a much loved Auschwitz survivor, these students explored the actual sites they had studied in the classroom in Ohio. Each chapter focuses on a different student, and how they experienced a different site. From Czechoslovakia to Poland to Israel to Holland, different student's experiences are described.This book was actually written by the high school teacher who hand picked these students, and guided them on the tour.This journey occurred in the mid seventies, before discussing holocaust was seen as acceptable, so it's among the first of kids really seeing what their parents hesitated to discuss, and experienced. I'm moved to tears every time I read this book. A "must" for every Holocaust library...
