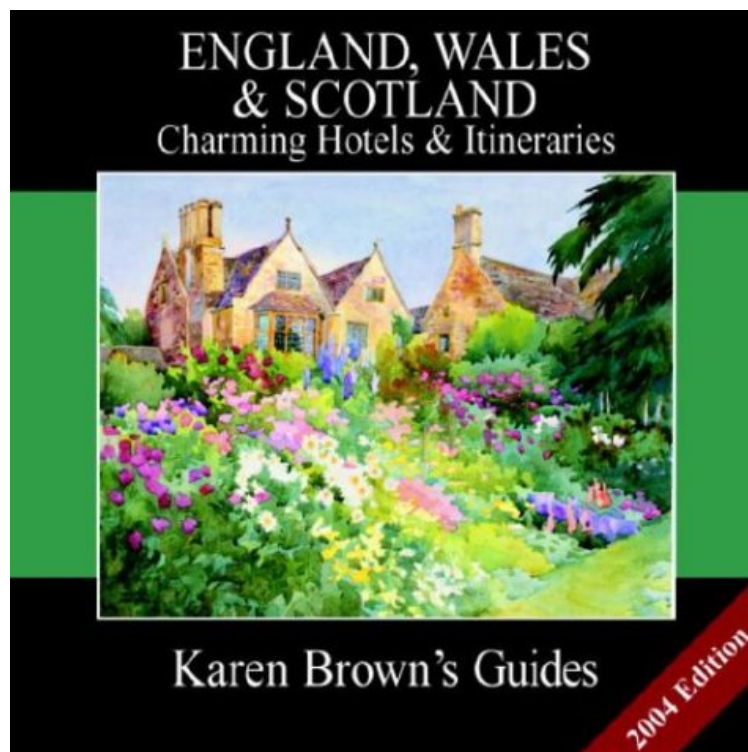

Some are better for the overall experience of visiting an area for the first time (eg. Frommer and Fodor). Some are better at museums and suggesting places to visit (eg. Rick Steves).Most are good at some things and poor at

others. Karen Brown is not good at describing the areas you may be considering, itineraries, etc. Rick Steves is lousy at inns and accommodations if you don't share his enthusiasm for going on the cheap and staying with local families. That doesn't make either a lousy travel guide. It just means they have certain fortes and you need to consult more than one guide. Karen Brown is in a league of her own at guiding the traveller to wonderful small inns, B B's and charming small hotels. How do I know? My wife and I have been taking her advice for nearly twenty years without a single misstep. At every small inn we've stayed at on her recommendation in (mostly) Europe, New England, Bucks County, PA, the Pacific Northwest, etc. we're always asked by the proprietor, "How did you find out about us?" When we say "Karen Brown. She's never let us down.", the response is always, "Everybody says that."
