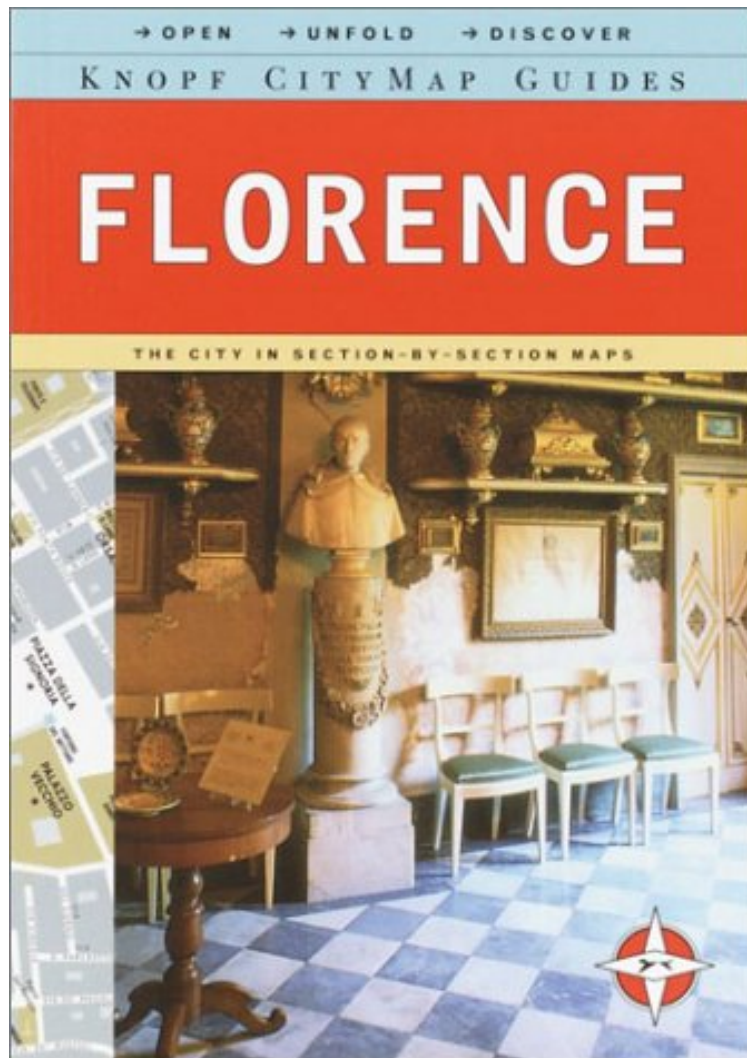

This one is far and away the best I've found. Divided into six clear sections (Centro Storico, Santa Maria Novella, San Lorenzo, Santa Croce, Santo Spirito/San Frediano, and San Miniato al Monte), it contains marvelously clear 10" x 7" foldout maps of each, with street names and buildings clearly marked, brief descriptions of the various sights, listings for restaurants, cafes and

shopping, and a useful section on transportation in Florence. Overall, it is 5" wide x 7" tall x 1/4" thick, sturdily made, and will easily fit in a jacket pocket. This opening fold-out contains a general map of Florence to help you visualize the 6 large districts discussed in this guide, and 4 pages of valuable information, handy tips and useful addresses. Discover Florence through 6 districts and 6 maps: Centro Storico, Santa Maria Novella, San Lorenzo, Santa Croce, Santo Spirito/ San Frediano, San Miniato al Monte. For each district there is a double-page of addresses (restaurants — listed in ascending order of price — cafés, bars, music venues and stores) followed by a fold-out map for the relevant area with the essential places to see (indicated on the map by a star *). These places are by no means all that Florence has to offer but to us they are unmissable. The grid-referencing system (A B2) makes it easy for you to pinpoint addresses quickly on the map. Transportation and hotels in Florence. The last fold-out consists of a transportation map and 4 pages of practical information that include a selection of hotels. A thematic index lists all the sites and addresses featured in this guide.
