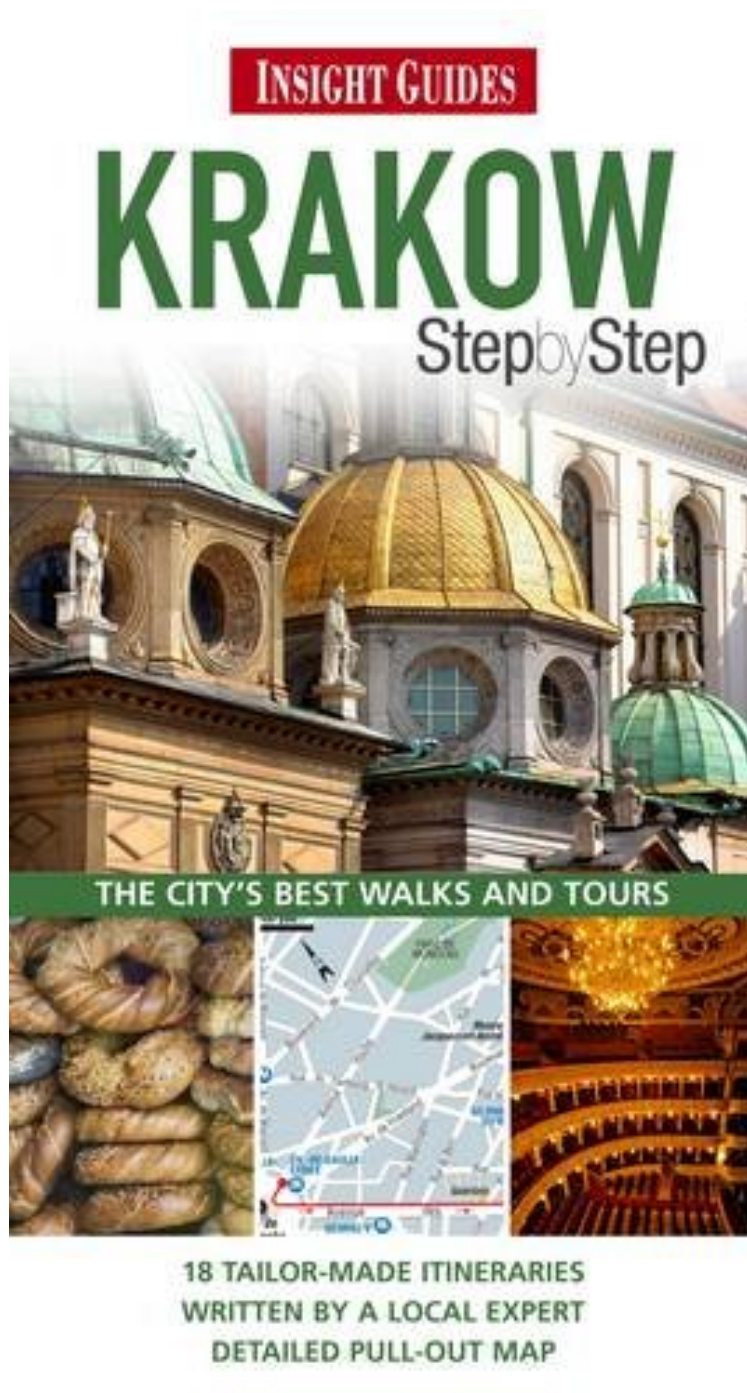

Krakow's Old Town is small enough that it is feasible to cover it by walking, and this book's suggested walking tours organize the sights excellently.

Step by Step Krakow is a travel guide containing a selection of self-guided walks around one of Europe's up-and-coming destinations, encompassing all of the city's must-see sights. Fascinating Walks and Tours present 16 walks of varying lengths to experience the city and beyond; from the medieval sights of Main Market Square and compelling history of Podgorze, the Jewish Ghetto, to excursions to Auschwitz and Wieliczka Salt Mine. Clear and detailed maps plot the tours, and a pull-out map, with all of the walks clearly marked, can be used with or without the guide. Overview chapters introduce the city and explore the food and drink, shopping and entertainment on offer. A Directory of practical information is provided to help with planning a trip and selected hotel and restaurant listings are included. Full-color photographs throughout and a fresh, modern design help to illustrate the vibrancy of Krakow and give a flavor of Polish life today.
