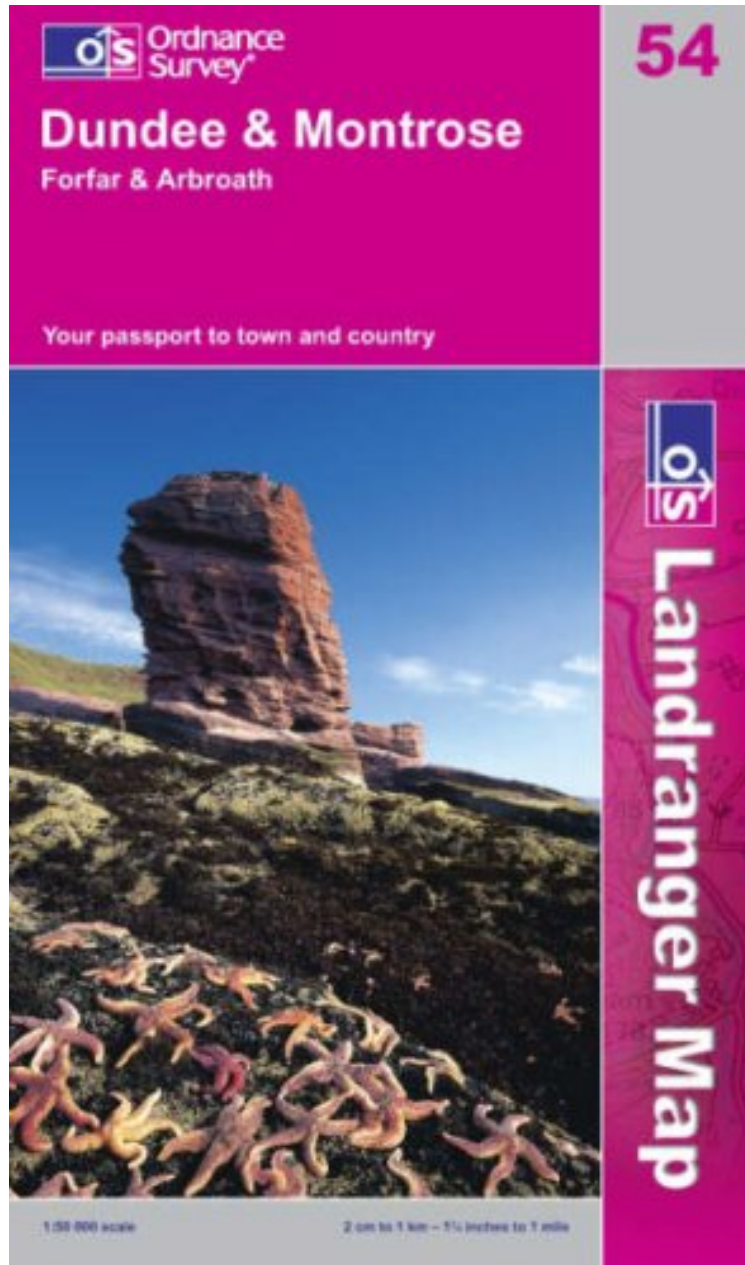

0 of 0 people found the following review helpful. Visiting Tayside...By HMS WarspiteTayside probably gets less attention than it might be due from visitors to Scotland. Located on the Firth of Tay and the North Sea, the area between the moderate-sized city of Dundee and the smaller city of Montrose seems on the way to somewhere else. Across the Firth of Tay is St Andrews, the Scottish home of golf. Further up the North Coast is the large city of Aberdeen. Behind the coastal plain are the Angus Glens and the Grampian Mountains. West of this area is Perth, a traditional entrance to the Highlands. Tayside has some attractions to offer on its own. Dundee is the home of HMS Unicorn, built in 1824, and the Royal Research Discovery, which carried the ill-fated Scott Expedition to Antarctica. North of Dundee is Glamis Castle, once the childhood home of the present Queen and a fascinating amalgam of castle and chateau. Over the Sidlaw Hills from Dundee are Kirriemuir and Forfar, both fascinating small towns. Along the North Sea are some extensive stretches of beach (on very cold water). Landranger Map 54 (Dundee Montrose), like others in this series, is set at a scale of 1:50,000, ideally suited for automobile, foot, and bicycle exploration. The multicolored presentation has excellent detail of terrain, contour, and physical structures. It is very highly recommended to those planning to explore this often overlooked corner of Scotland.

Perfect for day trips and short breaks, the OS Landranger Map series covers Great Britain with 204 detailed maps. Each map provides all the information you need to get to know your local area and includes places of interest, tourist information, picnic areas and camp sites, plus Rights of Way information for England and Wales.
