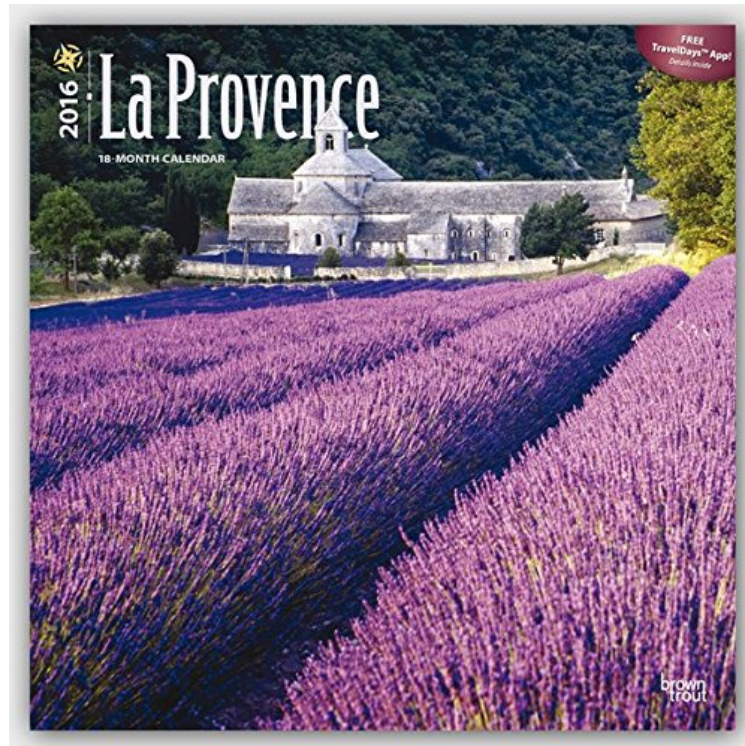

I've noticed that Windows 10 is now commencing the morning with a lovely and striking picture, and asking "do you like it." And the TV does the same thing, without the question, since the answer should be obvious. I've had a "personal" relationship with Provence now for over a quarter century... and hope, insh'allah, to have many more years. For at least the past 20 years the annual calendar that hangs on the wall, denoting time's ever so fleeting passage, has been one with the images of Provence, 12 to be precise. This year's selection of 12 images is a pleasant mixture of the traditional and the unique. In the traditional category are the lavender fields in front of the Abbey de Senanque, Pont du Gard (and how this Roman bridge, built around the year 50, has changed over that quarter century, all under the guise of restoration) and the sunflowers. And then there are unique views of traditional subjects, Mont Ventoux, snow-covered, with the village of Brante in the foreground, Mont Ste. Victoire, of Cezanne fame, with an autumn vineyard in the foreground, and even the entrance to the Trade Court in Aix. Provence does stretch, and vary, from the mountains to the sea. Representative of the latter image, is the "fishing village" of Saint Tropez. Long may that image linger, as an effective tourist "magnet", helping preserve some of the other Mediterranean villages for the locals.
