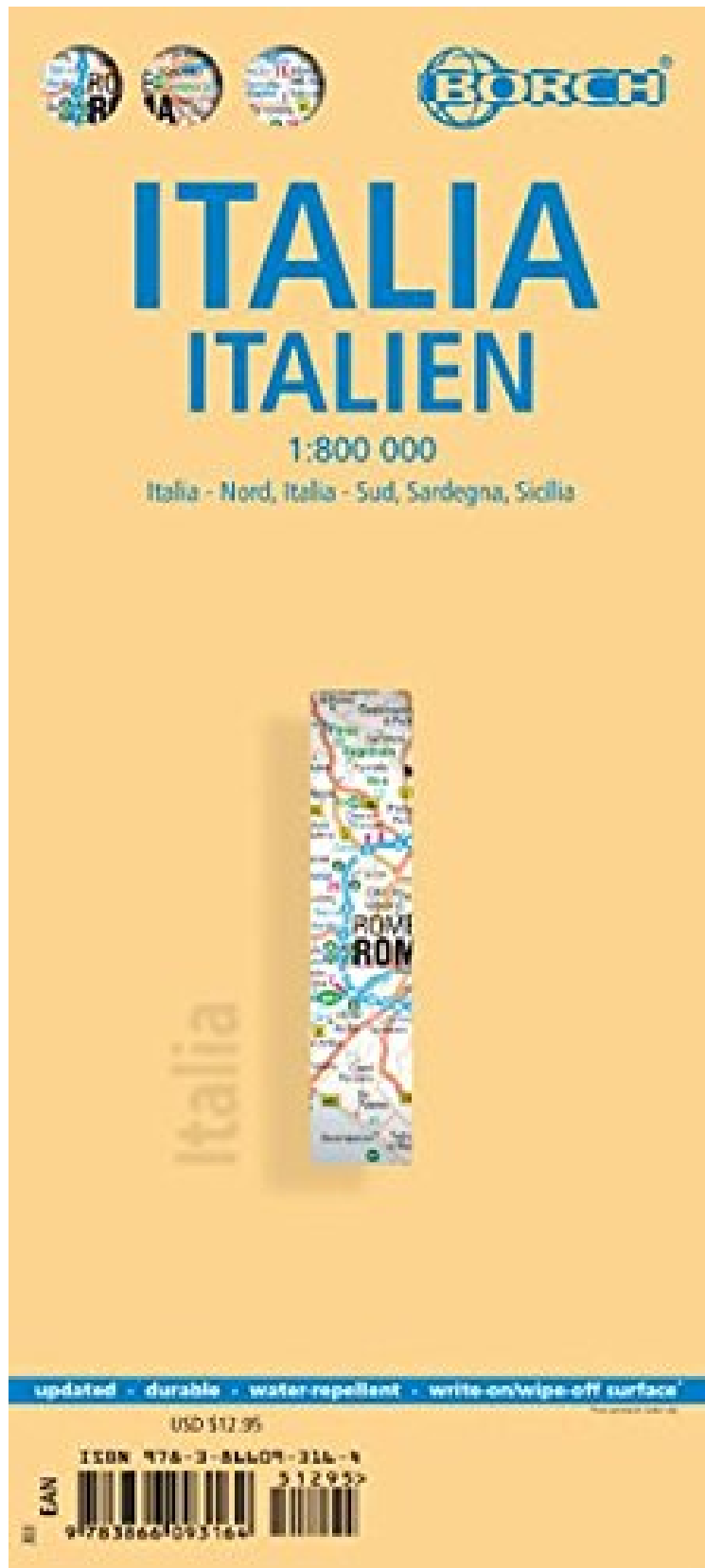

The text on the map is printed clearly with demarcations for important sights and landmarks. The maps are laminated which allows us to use dry erase markers to mark places that are of special interest to us (hotels, etc.) without permanently damaging the maps.
