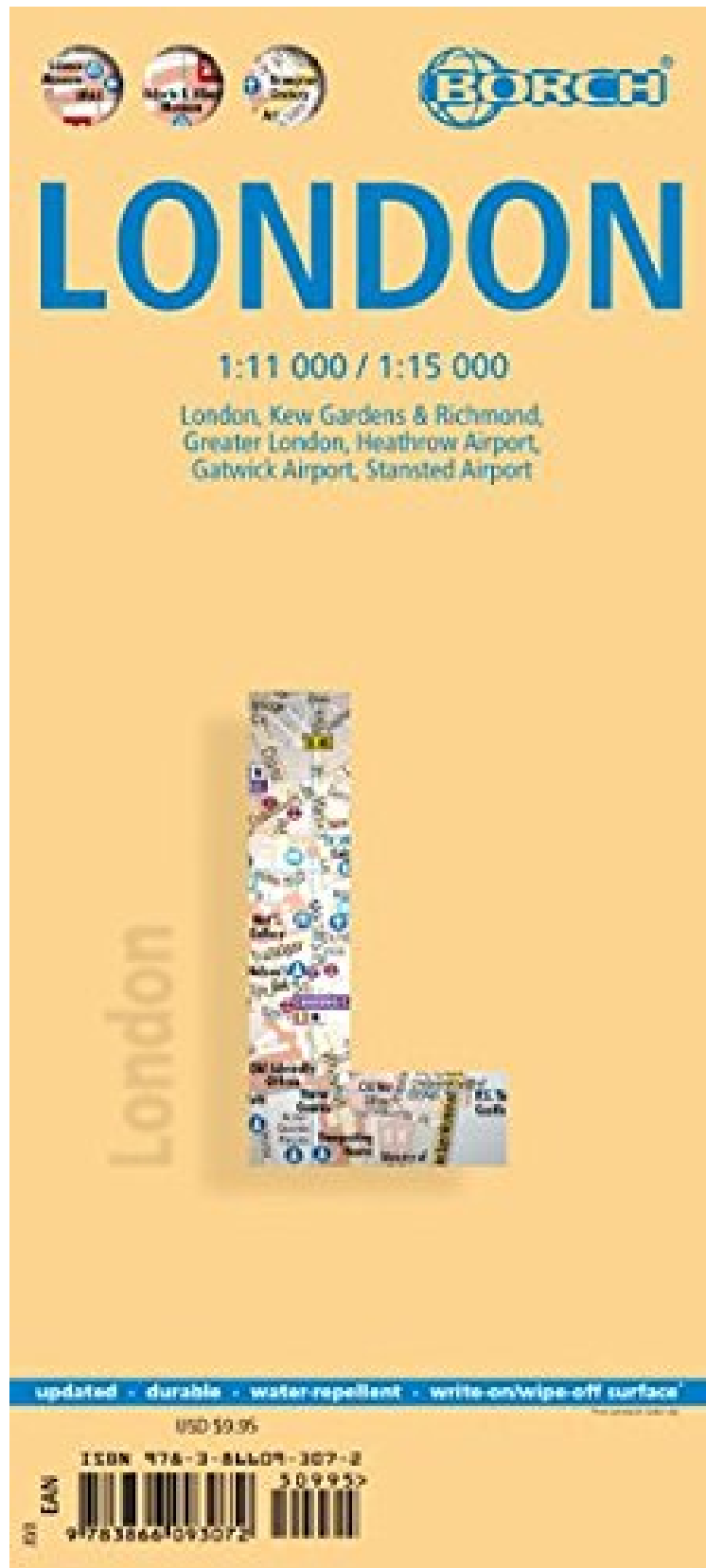

They are larger than most laminated city travel maps, enabling them to cover more area, have a more legible street/site lookup, and have more inset maps. At first, I avoided ordering this map because the description indicated it was the 6th edition, dated 2009, which would be somewhat outdated. I ended up ordering anyhow, and was relieved that the product delivered is the 17th edition, with a 2016 copyright date. I like the map, but I can't quite give it 5 stars because the Tube map has a microscopic font for the station names and there is adequate space to have printed the text in a more readable size. By Donna Thomas At least for our trip, this is far and away the best of the nearly dozen London maps I've seen. It manages to include Portobello Road market, Camden Town tube station, Greenwich, and a very usable inset for Kew. Getting even one of those areas in usable form on other maps has been rare. Getting all four, along with a good but readable level of detail is remarkable. Bonus points for the discreet inclusion of major shops (MS, especially), because it's nice to know where we can pop into a food hall if we're feeling peckish. Only wish item is Abbey Road - they include St. John's Wood tube station (yay!) but only need about another millimeter or two of room to pick up Abbey Road, but they don't. It is laminated and a bit bulky but it has everything you need.
