Heck, these maps hardly even compete with maps made by the USGS. The contour intervals are hard to determine, the scale is incredibly small, (1km = about 3in), and the map is made out of paper, which seems highly inappropriate for a country so prone to precipitation. Further, the map is only printed on one side, so while you could bet two maps for the space of one, you still have to carry both. Just cause.

This map is part of the Landranger (Pink) series and is designed for people who really want to get to know an area. It includes the following information: tourist information, camping and caravan sites, picnic areas and viewpoints, selected places of interest and rights of way information for England and Wales. Each map in the series covers an area of 40 km by 40 km (25 miles by 25 miles) and like other Ordnance Survey maps, National Grid squares are provided so that any feature can be given a unique reference number.
