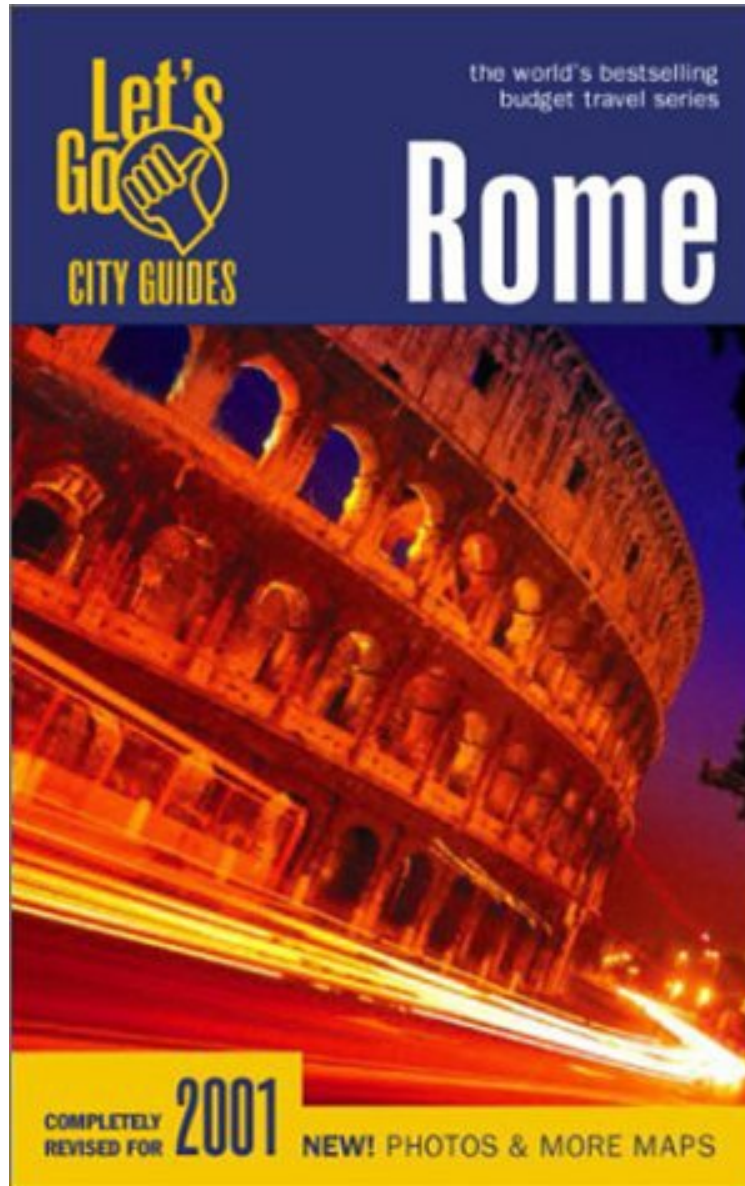

The thumbing problem is partly because the rest of the book is printed on paper that's one notch up from newsprint. Illustrations are black and white and the index is inadequate. All in all, a disappointment. I'll leave my copy behind.
