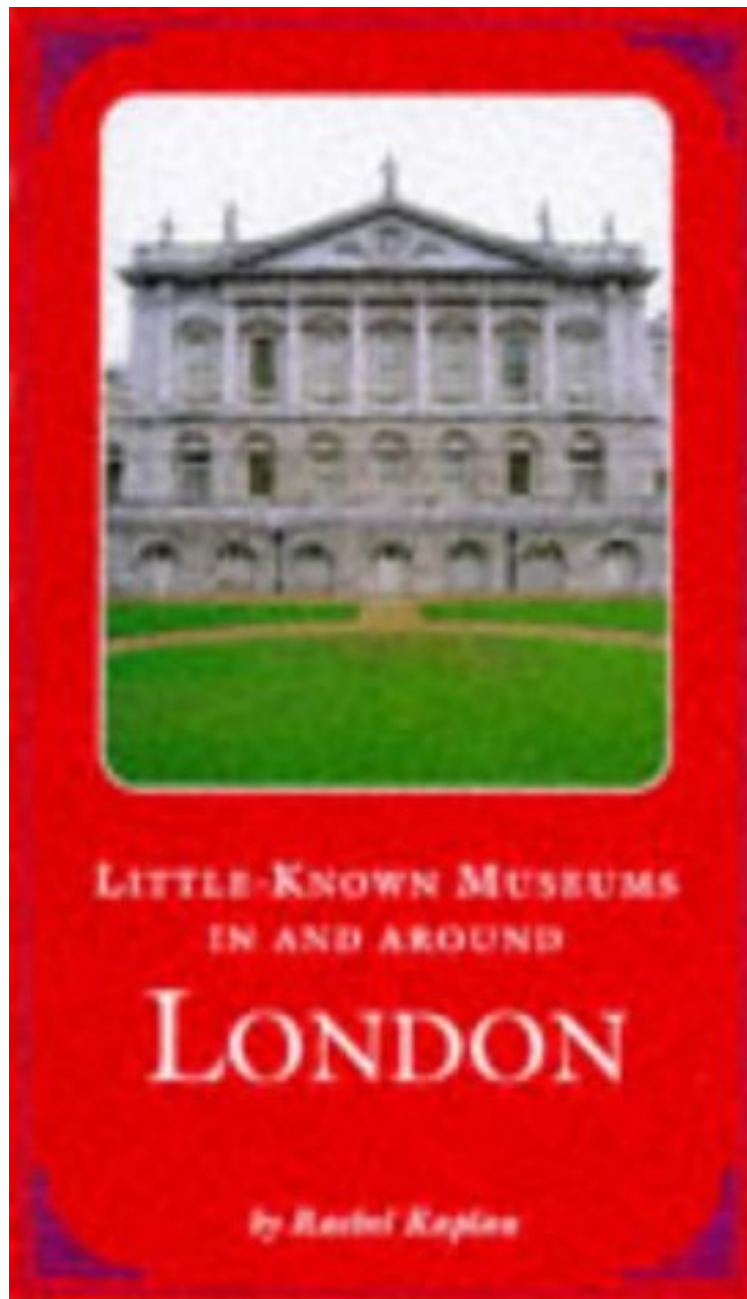

This is one of those books that shows you the way to some cool experiences that are close enough to reach but just enough off the beaten path to be unusual. This is just a great little travel book. If you travel a lot you're used to the limitations of the vast majority of travel guides. One hopes for some useful tips and endures a great deal of careless and/or banal commentary in order to get them. Only very rarely do I find myself actually enjoying something the writer has to say. But in Little Known Museums there's something on every page. The author has obviously paid a great deal of attention, has absorbed a tremendous amount of information and gives it back to us with masterful concision. This book says more in three pages than most guides do in twenty! And Kaplan writes crisply, engagingly and just plain well. She has gone to great lengths to put quality in every sentence. It's a relief to find writers still willing - and able - to do that. In Berlin I kept translating stuff from the book for my German friends - longtime residents of Berlin - and they marveled at how much they were learning about their own city. I will use this sturdy little navigational aid again with pleasure -- and will pick up the companion volumes on London and Rome.
