Of all the books, all the websites, all the experiences we've shared...these cards present them as simply, as starkly, more helpfully than any resource I've encountered before. I wish they'd been available for our earlier visits to London.If you buy only one resource for taking kids to London, within the next year or two (assuming that things will alter significantly around/after the 2012 Olympics), I cannot recommend this one highly enough. I wish it had been available for our first trip, updated for subsequent trips; hope it'll be frequently updated in the future, and expanded to include all of the UK (like visiting Lyme Regis for fossil hunting - unforgettable!).And if the authors/publishers keep this collection current, you will not need any other Kids/Family resource for visiting London.
