I was looking for a book geared specifically to someone traveling alone - hotels that are safe and welcoming to the single traveler (particularly the single female tourist), restaurants where single patrons would not feel out of place, etc. I have been to London twice before as a single traveler and hoped that this book would enhance my next experience in that city. Although the book had very good over-all information for anyone visiting London, it had little to do with traveling independently. As a general London travel book I could have given it a higher rating, but had to settle for three stars as it did not help me any more than any other London travel book as far as advice for the single independent traveler.
