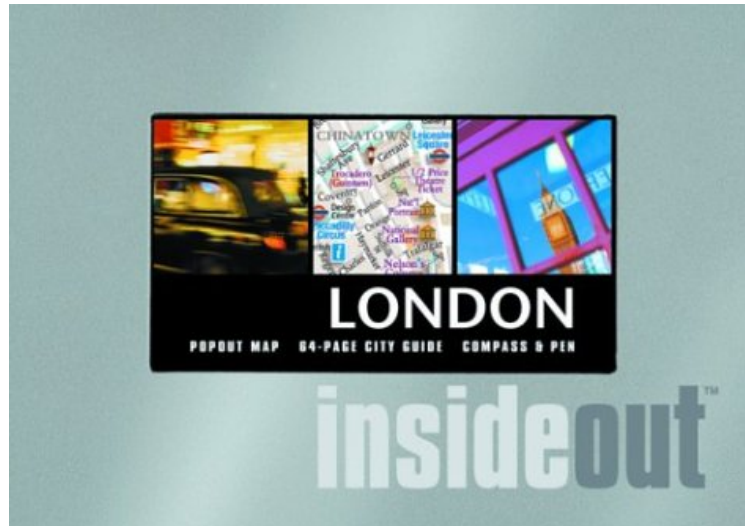

After each category, the guide lists the stores' specialties. There are 54 entertainment venues covering themes from the Opera and Theatre to Dance Clubs and Sporting Arenas, with a detailed description of each, what it has to offer, and its location.
