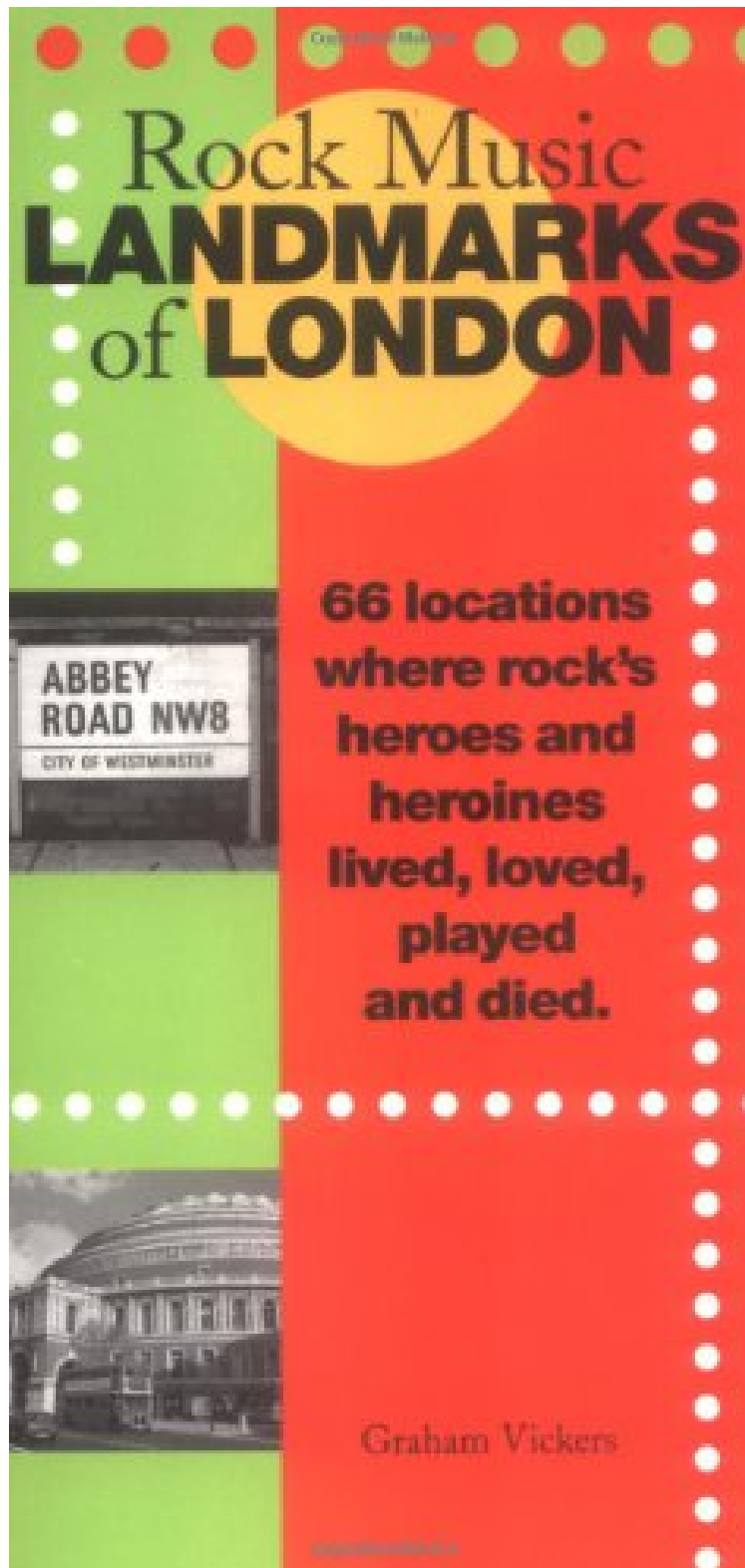

It focuses almost exclusively on Beatles, Who, Rolling Stones, Hendrix, Bowie and Sex Pistols. Other top notch London groups like Queen, Elton John, and Cliff Richard get very short and unsatisfying mentions. Other passers-by to the London scene barely rate at all - Adam Ant, Pretenders, U2. And others are completely absent - English Beat for one. Meanwhile, we learn where Sir Paul bought his socks. Well done for what it is, but far too limited to appeal to a wide array of readers.
