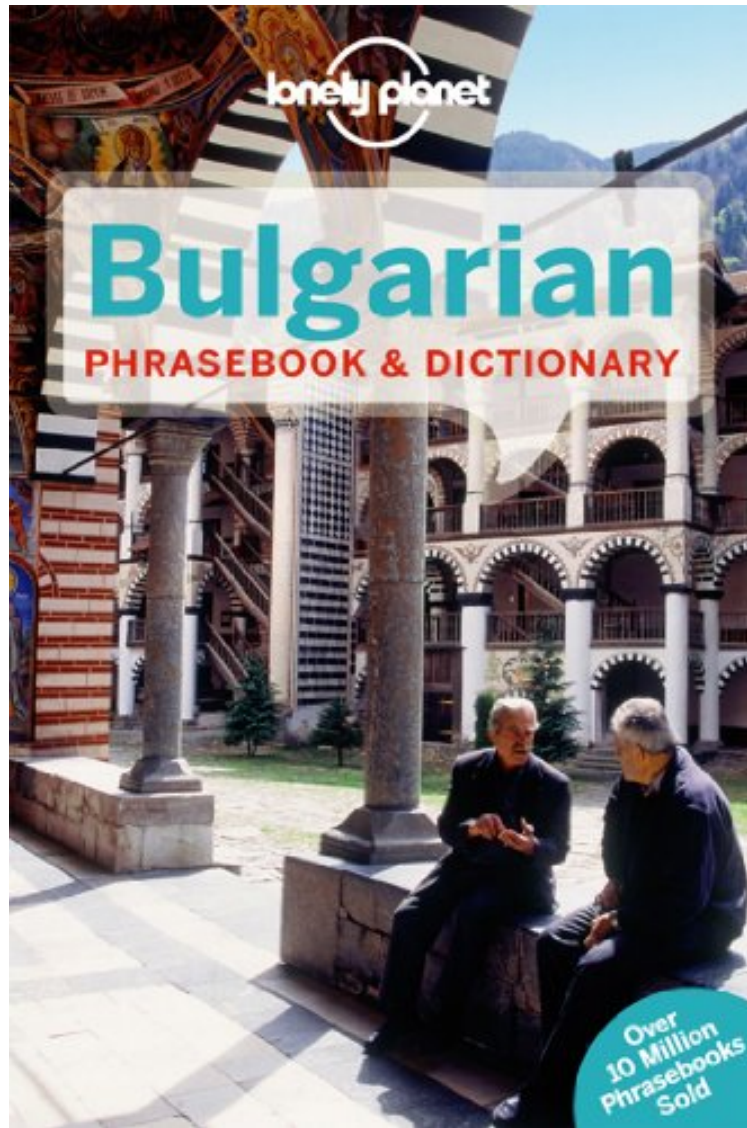

This was a really helpful book for my short 9-day trip to Bulgaria, but it's written for a stay of a few months. I left it behind in the country with a friend who will be there longer. Most of the words and phrases I needed were here, and the book layout was thought through. LP spends a whole chapter up front describing the alphabet and phrase building, which is interesting, but just marginally helpful for a short trip. From that perspective it would be handy to have a more lengthy lexicon of phrases up front to get around on the fly. The pronunciation guides were good and easy to follow. My suggestion would be to dedicate an entire quick reference section up front for the most needed phrases and words.
