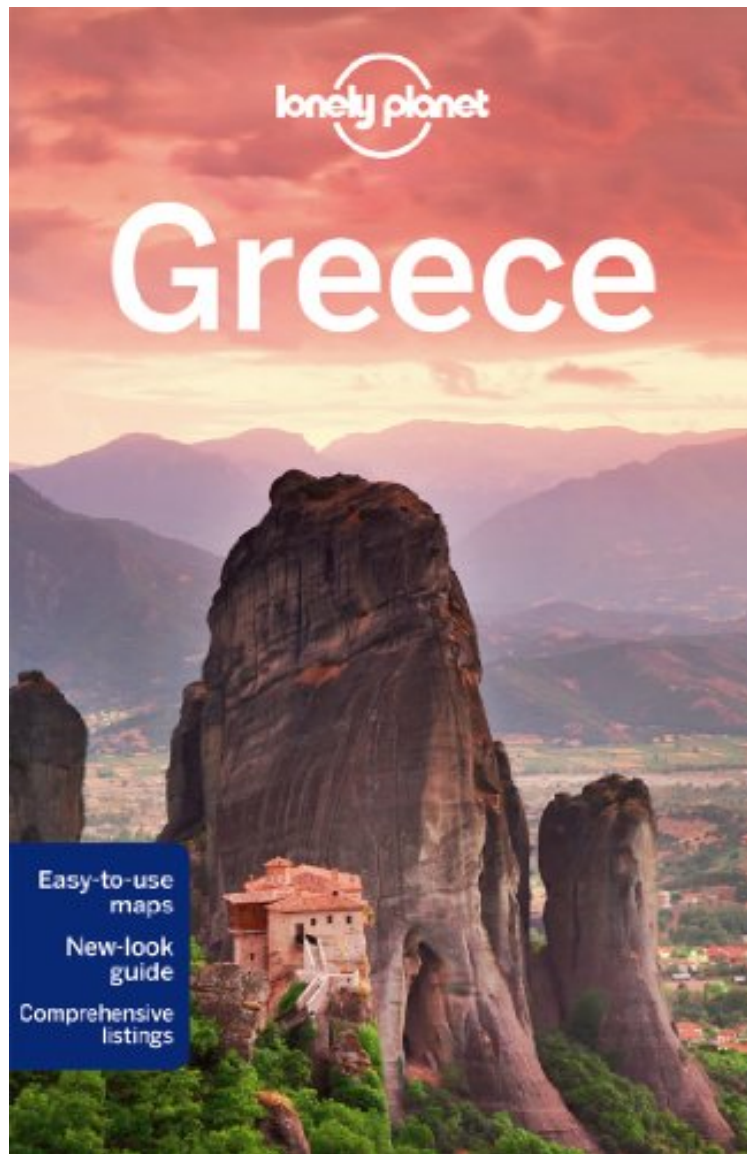

Albee There's so much competition in travel guides these days that timeliness sometimes trumps quality. Not so with this excellent guide to Europe's mother country. First let me say that the geographic coverage is absolutely comprehensive. No corner of Greece is left unexplored by the authors here. Likewise, the range of interests represented, from outdoor activities to historic exploration to activities to do with children, is as diverse as the landscape. Lonely Planet has suffered from erratic quality control in the last decade, but you can be sure that this book sets a high standard for encyclopedic travel guides. Both the guide itself and the important historical and cultural contexts are excellent. Listings of hotels, restaurants and shopping are also excellent, though they are selective. Not every single possible option is included, but only the locations the writers believe will interest travelers. The writers are interested in providing an authentic travel experience, so you can be sure their recommendations are spot on. If your travels include the whole of Greece, this is the best comprehensive guide published. Even if your attention is focused, you'll be well directed with this guide.
