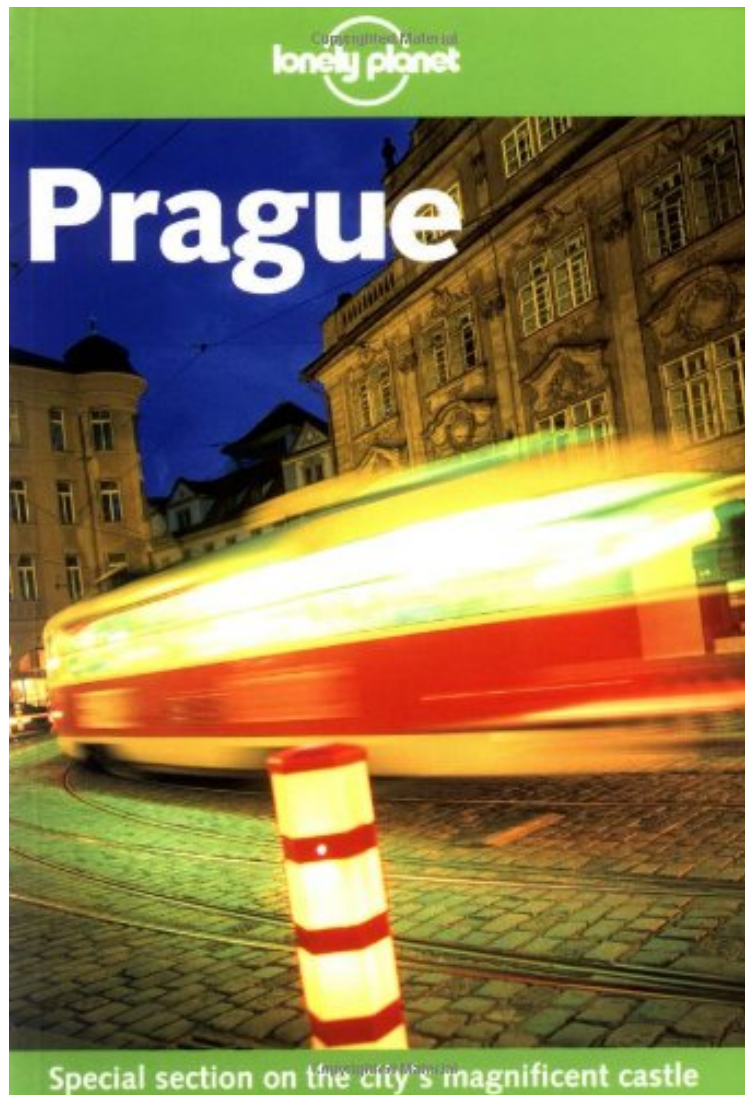

But actually being in Prague and using the book to get around to different sights and restaurants was extremely difficult. Instead of having a chapter on a specific neighborhood with everything in that neighborhood, they have a chapter on neighborhoods, then shopping, then eating, then drinking, then entertainment, etc. Having to flip to the eating section, then flip back to the neighborhood

section, then flip to the map to see where it was located was very time consuming and annoying. Another thing I didn't like was that the writing on the maps was much too small.
