But personally, I can't get enough of them. Why? The specific, insider-y information makes me feel like a rockstar. In partic, I love the shopping itineraries -- the ones for Madrid were particularly good -- even when I don't actually purchase anything. They are divided by area, so you can hit a whole district's boutiques at once. The stores and restaurants mentioned in the itineraries are also cross-referenced on other pages under headings like "brunch" or "top shopping." Personally, I can think of nothing more fun than strolling around stores in a foreign city. Again, I know this is not everyone's idea of a good time. They would NOT be into the Luxe guides, though. The food recommendations are impeccable, too. Our concierge in Madrid suggested some of the same places that I had read about in Luxe -- it was like they were "double approved" so that's never a bad thing! Just a tip though: these don't have maps in them or visual depictions of anything, so you really have to commit to reading them in detail and then locating them on a map later. But anyone who is still considering buying this guide shouldn't be deterred by that though. My solution is to take a map or use my smartphone to see streets/areas that are mentioned in the guides just to make sure I am not getting lost.
