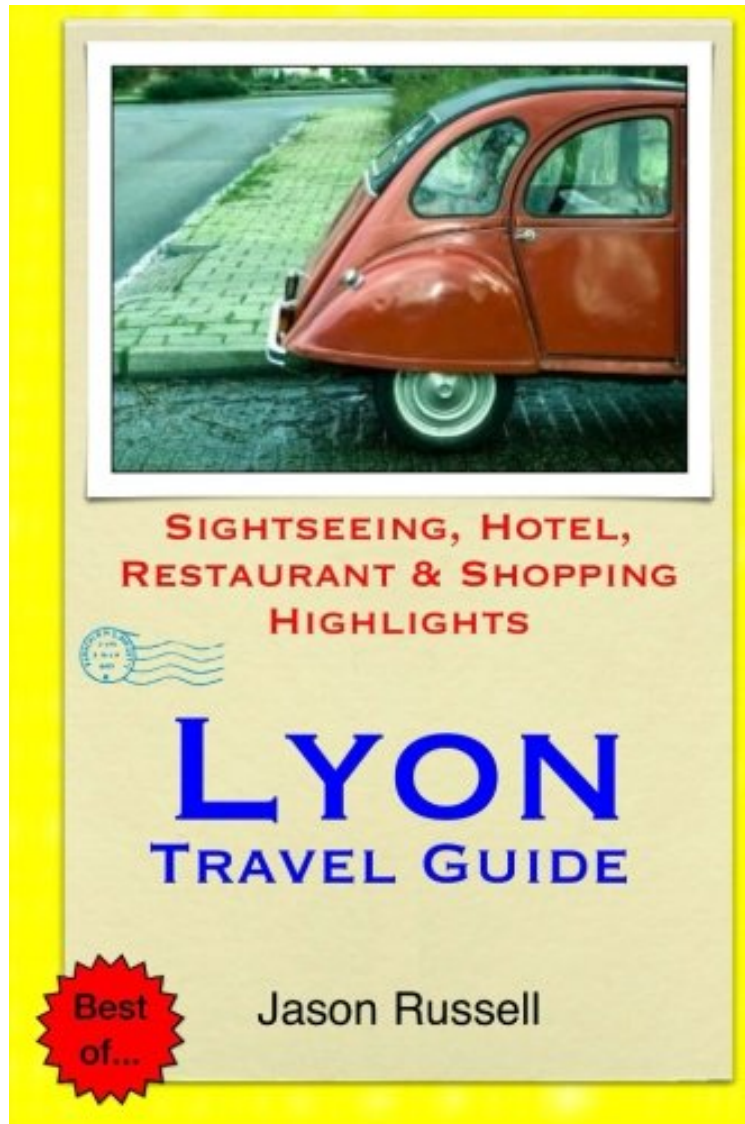

To start with, the first hotel recommended, the Hilton Hotel in Lyon, is priced at 150-200 euros a night - for the "budget" traveler?! What is more - this particular hotel has officially been closed since almost 1 year ago from the date of publication! There is no itinerary guide in any form, and no picture, map, transportation route, or any thing of practical use. The author offers no particular information on the use of the Lyon City Card, apart from "free access to public transportation". No wonder every unfortunate reader of this booklet has a strong suspicion that the writer has never ever travelled to Lyon in person. Large font, half empty pages, and no photos. Pages are similar to newspaper material, poor production quality, not something that would stand up to travel, although this wouldn't be good for travel in any case. After reading this book (it took about 5 minutes to read the entire thing) I have serious doubts that the author has ever visited the City of Lyon.
