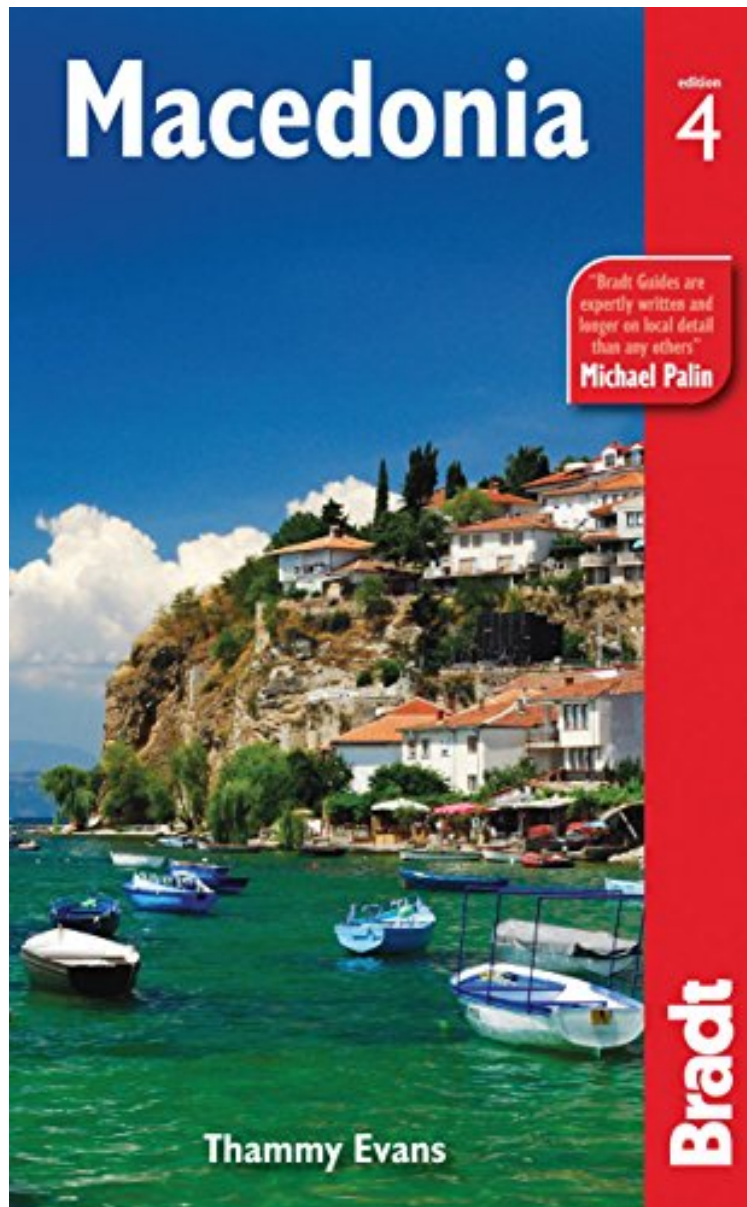

hotels and restaurants, this is the book. It contains a wealth of information on the most important sights, many very useful maps, and a lot of background contextual information on the country. If read carefully it will help you understand the importance of what you are seeing (such as how the Byzantine art of Macedonia preceded and influenced the Italian Renaissance) and local customs (such as the belief drafts are unhealthful, even on a sweltering bus or train). Being country specific, it contains far more information than guidebooks devoted to broader areas such as the Western Balkans.
