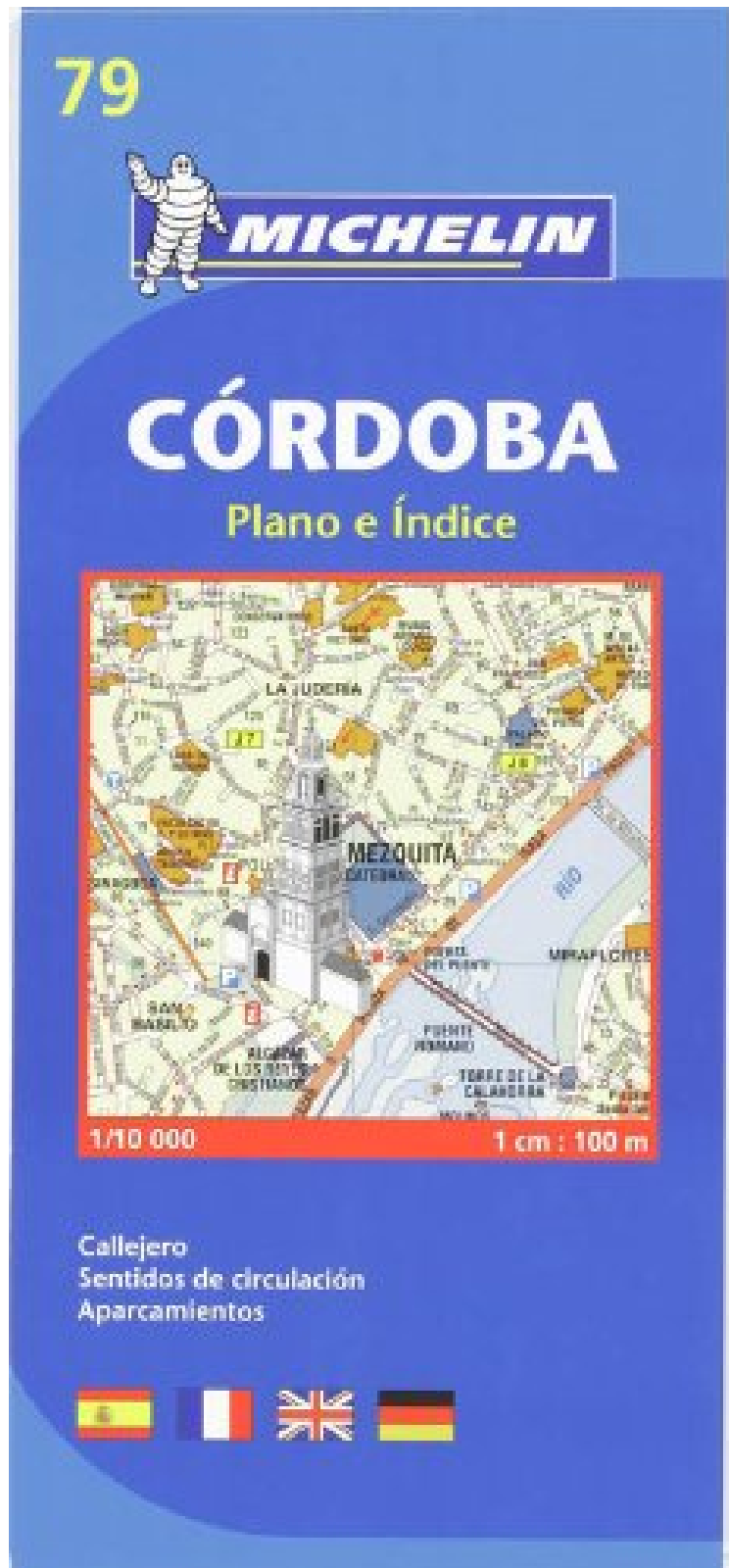

By Lee by the Sea As printed, the map was fine, but Book Depository did a really slipshod job of shipping it. They packed this 10.0-inch-long, giant folded paper map in a cheap bubble bag that has only 9.0 inches of bubbles from bottom to flap. [Photo available on request.] So up at the top, there was nothing but paper to protect the end of the map. You can guess what happened--that end of the map got crunched on a corner. Open up the map, and at every internal corner where the map is folded, it is crushed like a Kleenex in your back pocket. It is probably in just one of those crushed corners that I will need to read the tiny print of this map and won't be able to. Bad job, Book Depository! Use a longer bag if the map barely fits, or use bubble bags that don't cut corners and ends. I won't buy maps from these folks again, nor should you. // As for the map, it is about what I expected. Aimed more at road travelers than at urban tourists, it is all at one large scale, so the cramped ancient streets of Cordoba require a magnifying loupe to see what goes where and to read the mouseprinted street names.
